Find out what bins are available, and recycle when possible.



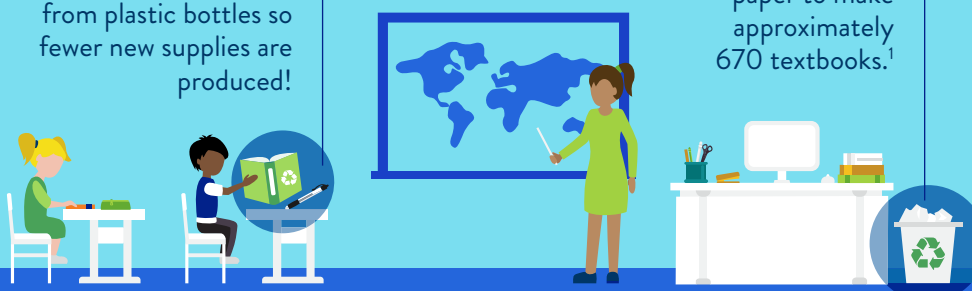
CLASSROOM

RECYCLE ALL USED PAPER

Recycling one ton of paper saves 15 trees. That's enough paper to make approximately 670 textbooks.¹



CAFETERIA

COMPOST LEFTOVER LUNCHES

Encourage your cafeteria to start a composting program—one student can prevent almost 10 lbs of waste from going to the landfill each week.²

PUT IT IN THE BIN

Put any paper, plastics, aluminum cans, or glass from your lunch in the recycling bin—every plastic bottle recycled saves enough energy to power a computer for 25 minutes!³



OUTDOORS

PICK UP LITTER

Plastic bottles take up to 400 years to decompose in a landfill. Toss them in the recycling bin so they can live a new life!⁴

SAVE SPACE

Recycling one ton of aluminum cans saves 10 cubic yards of landfill space—you'd need 4 pickup trucks to haul all that! Lined up end-to-end, those cans would stretch the length of more than 70 soccer fields!⁵
